

Prepare-NS: Looking for Volunteers

Study Goal: Develop and validate a set of surveys focused on **swelling** fit for drug development for a range of **nephrotic syndrome (NS)** inducing rare kidney diseases

Study activity: A zoom or phone 30-60 long interview, during which we will ask about the patient's experiences with edema

Compensation: \$50 after interview completion

Group 1: People with Nephrotic Syndrome

- Adults
- Children at least 8 years old
- Must be able to speak and understand English
- Have a diagnosis of Nephrotic Syndrome or Minimal Change Disease, **FSGS**, IgM Nephropathy, or Membranous Nephropathy before or after kidney transplant
- Must have current swelling or experienced swelling within the past 3 months
- Must not be receiving dialysis

Group 2: Parents or caregivers of children with Nephrotic Syndrome

- Parent or guardian must be at least 18 years old Caring for a child aged 2-11 years
- Must be able to read and understand English
- Child must have a diagnosis of Nephrotic Syndrome or specific kidney disease that causes nephrotic syndrome such as Minimal Change Disease, **FSGS**, IgM Nephropathy, or Membranous Nephropathy before or after kidney transplant
- Their child must have current swelling or a history of swelling within the past 3 months
- Their child must not be receiving dialysis
